

### Payment Policy

Thank you for choosing Casco Bay Speech Therapy for your speech-language pathology needs. This is an agreement between Casco Bay Speech Therapy and you for payment of services provided. By signing this agreement, you are agreeing to pay for all services provided to you or your family member.

#### Please read the following information carefully.

Casco Bay Speech Therapy does not bill insurance for evaluations and treatment. I can provide you with the information you need to submit a bill to your insurance company.

If you plan to submit bills to your insurance company, you should:

- Check with your insurance company before your first visit to find out what speech and language services they will pay for.
- Find out what information the insurance company needs.
  - You may need a note from your doctor, called a referral. You may need permission from the insurance company, called pre-authorization.
  - Referrals and pre-authorizations do not guarantee that insurance will pay for services.

#### Payment Options:

- Following sessions, you will be provided with a bill for services. This bill must be paid by the date indicated on the bill.
- I am happy to talk about other payment arrangements, if needed. Talk to me ahead of time to make payment arrangements. Please don't wait until you are not able to pay to talk to me.

#### Fee Schedule (Cost for Services) *(updated 1/2025)*

Service	Cost
Evaluation	\$250/first hour
	\$25/each additional 15 minutes
Treatment	\$98/hour session
	\$81/45 minute session
	\$54/half hour session
Consultation (outside of treatment time)	Determined on an individual basis
Group Treatment	A 25% discount is given for all group sessions

**Returned checks:**

- You will be charged a \$20 fee for each returned check.
- You will be asked to bring cash to the office to cover the amount of the returned check and the fee.

**Past due accounts:**

- If you have a bill outstanding for 7 days or more, your therapy sessions will be put on hold until that bill is paid. After 30 days of an unpaid bill, you will be discharged from therapy.
